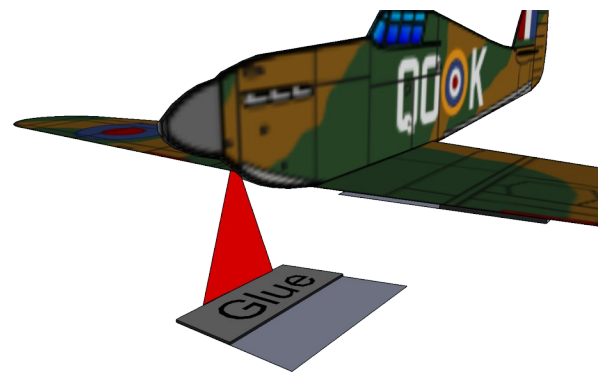
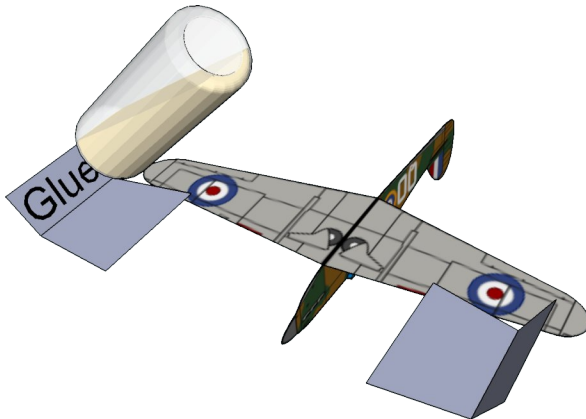
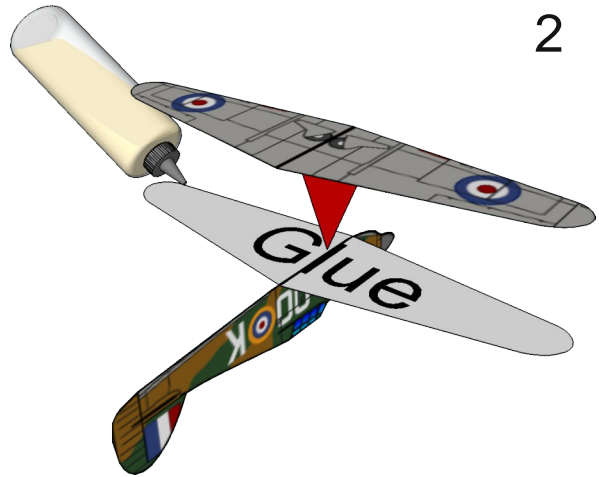
Tips for Assembly

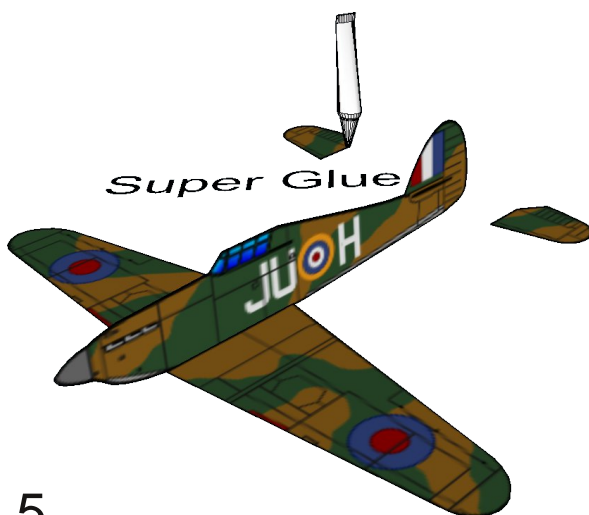
